

2022 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET

Eligibility: Graduating High School Seniors and Current College/Technical School Students

To be considered for a 705 FCU scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a member in good standing of 705 Federal Credit Union.
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2022, currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school full-time in the fall of 2022. (Those that have plans to attend an accredited college, university, or technical school full-time in the fall of 2022 are also eligible.)
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or a 3.0 overall GPA for your college transcript.
- Complete an application and personal essay.

Application Package: All applicants must submit an application package which includes:

- A completed application (attached)
- A current high school transcript or college transcript.
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from your junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or your current college professor or advisor.
- A personal essay

Application Deadline:

Completed application package must be submitted no later than **Friday, March 4, 2022**. **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.** Send application package by mail, email, or fax to:
